As an Injection Mould Toolmaker, you will be responsible for the on time & accurate delivery of tools to meet tooling programmes safely and efficiently carrying out manufacture preparation, assembly, fitting, and repair of both new and existing tools.

- Attending machine/tooling breakdowns to identify the root cause and solve the problem
